
### Cumbre del Sol January – February – March 2010

Below are a few snow pictures from Kverneland.










Normally there is not much snow at Gran in December eighter, but this year the snow came about Christmas. The 25<sup>th</sup> of December we went for a walk in the snow.

Here we look over to the harbour




Here we see a little part of the town
