
GEORGIA 1. SEPTEMBER - 8. SEPTEMBER 2016























There is much sandstone in the area, and we saw many landslide areas up along the valley.




On the way to the pass, we drive past <u>Russia Georgia</u> <u>Friendship Monument</u>, which was erected in 1983.




The bus did not stop, so we did not looked into it.

These are the mountains around <u>Stepantsminda</u>.










We stayed at Rooms Hotel in Stepandsminda or Katzbegi as that place was called before. Two nights here.

Here are we going in through the wall gates.




There are two churches here. This is the oldest.
