Inside the small workshop where they made smaller objects.


This is laminated timber.



The have started the processing of a column.




They have certainly some machinery in addition to the ax.

Here we are going to visit a retired couple.




The guide is telling how it is to be a pensioner in Russia. The wages are low in Russia, but the pensions are quite high.
