The apartment belongs to Stærvegen borettslag AL.




































On the basis of these images and the rest of the ad we bought the apartment unseen. The price was very cheap, but we figured that we had to brush up a bit. We took over the apartment 1 April and we were then in Kongsvinger and retrieved the keys. We had planned to move in 1 May and do renovations over time, but when we started working, we found out quickly that this was not practical. We decided then to postpone the moving in until we had finished the renovation.

It was very worn anywhere, so we decided that we were going to renovate all the rooms. We started to rip out everything, such as fixed cabinets, closets and kitchen cabinets, and even wallpaper. Nothing was usable.

We were with <u>Sandermoen AS</u> at <u>Kirkenær</u> and bought paints, fillers and various equipment. Then we began to fill in the cracks and to paint and we held out for three weeks. Then we were exhausted and we found out that we were not professional, we worked too slow and the result was not satisfactory. We gave up and left the rest of the work of Sandermoen. We also ordered flooring laminate and sheet vinyl flooring there. Then they did all the work. We were very satisfied with the job they did.



This is the beginning of April, and there is still snow on the slope behind the apartment.

The chimney was smeared in with a thick layer of texture paint. It was flaky and not very nicely, so I spent three days to remove the layer.





This is how it looked at Gran 13 April.

There were many trips back and forth to Kongsvinger, so it was necessary to have good studded tires.





We had to have food to strengthen us.












The laundry room is now delicate in comparison to the way it was.


The furntures here are from Flisesenteret and the closet is from Jysk.

A glance out onto the balcony. It is not finished yet. We plan to complete it in the spring of 2014, after we are back from Cyprus.






