The border crossing here in Utsjoki is the worlds most northern border crossing.




A bit further to the south we met this reindeer. We saw reindeer a lot times when we went through Finland.

This is at <u>Ljusnefors Camping</u>. It is a small and idyllic site.




Day 21 we are pushing on to Filipstad.
