This is Røysland old school.




Here is clothes and miscellaneous stuff outside the entrance. We got unloaded from the camper before those who should collect the stuff arrived.





Røed Camping is here.





The next day we went on to **Elverum**.




We stayed at Elverum Camping. We were there for 3 nights in June as well.
