The hotel was situated in the middle of small local center with a small open square and with a supermarket just across the square.


The upper picture shows the entrance to the hotel

One afternoon we went to the town and took a couple of pictures of the town, the harbor and the street life.












After a couple of hours there came a small bus and drove us to a central hotel. They collected all those there, who should go with that plain. We also got free lunch there.
