
The only stop this day was at the Cathedral in Trondheim. The church was started around 1070. It has (Pilegrimsleden)

Then we are inside the church. Here we took a lot of pictures.



























From Trondheim we drove directly to <u>Oppdal</u> where were going to stay at <u>Quality Hotel Skifer</u>.




The room looked like this.
