## **RIJEKA 19/20 AND 25/26 JUNE**

We are still working on visiting all the capital cities in Europe. This time we had decided to visit Lubljana and Zagreb. There are many ways to get there, but we eventually chose to travel with Norwegian to Rijeka, because they are going directly there. The plane departed so early in the morning that we thought it was best to drive to Gardermoen the day before stay overnight at a hotel near the airport.

We went by car to Clarion Hotel & Congress Oslo Airport and unloaded our luggage. Anne Berit waited there while I parked the car at <u>Dalen Parkering</u>. We took a taxi to the hotel where we were going to stay overnight until the next day. The taxi used about half an hour.



We had booked at Jadran Hotel, which is situated a bit south of the city center.







It lies at the heart of the Kvarner Gulf.


There is a railway here and the port has services for both Austria and Hungary.






