Check-in was so early this day that it was appropriate to have lunch. Here we have ordered. We are sitting in the courtyard of the hotel.




We shared a salad.

<u>Torre Cabrero</u> is a watchtower in Pozzallo. Originally built in the 15th century, it was enlarged and rebuilt in the following centuries.




Marina di Modica is a small town that is a popular resort.

Scicli was founded by the Siceli (hence probably the name) around 300 BCE.






On 17 October we drove on towards the airport to return the car. We had planned to drive through <u>Siracusa</u>, but that was also cancelled.

After we had delivered the car at the airport, we took a taxi to the hotel. We had booked at <u>Hotel VdB Next</u>.




Here we sit on the large roof terrace that belonged to the room.


Here we wait for a taxi to the airport.
