A few words about Fuengirola

Fuengirola was founded by the Phoenicians and is first mentioned in writings from the 1st century AD. It eventually became quite a big settlement. In the early Middle Ages, the city was set on fire by pirates and the people fled to Mijas. Fuengirola was then practically deserted until the 17th century, when the threat of Turkish and Moroccan pirates disappeared. A guesthouse was opened near the beach that offered accommodation for travelers, mule drivers and seafarers. A few cabins were also set up nearby and together this was a small village. Fishing and agriculture remained main industries for more than a century.

In the 1960s, Fuengirola entered a new phase and became a leading tourist center. Fuengirola now offers all the facilities expected by a major tourist resort, - hotels, restaurants, bars, discos, sports clubs, marina, and wide beaches along a promenade. Of the approx. 75,000 citizens registered in the municipality 25% are from other countries, mainly European.




