We were transported a short distance in a carriage that was pulled by a horse.








We were sitting here for a while.

After having walked so long in Mini Siam, we had to bring the liquid equilibrium in order.




The temple at a distance.

The building operations were on.







Kjell and the guide in the stairs leading into the temple.





It was possible to ride an elephant around the area.










The stairways seen from below. We get some «step-exercise»
