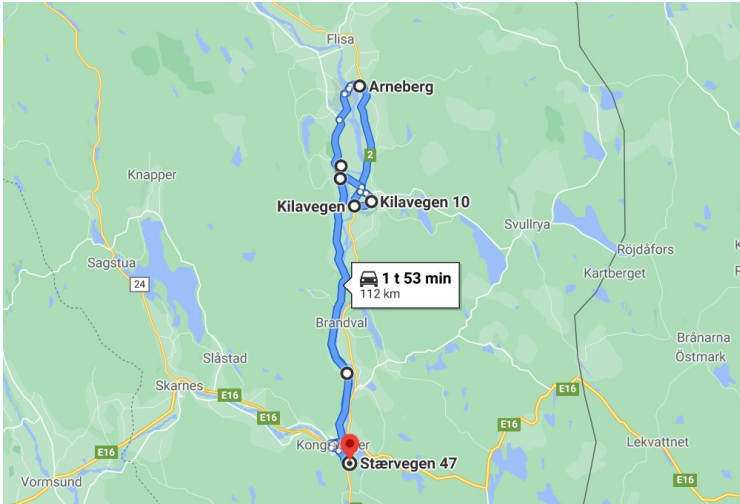


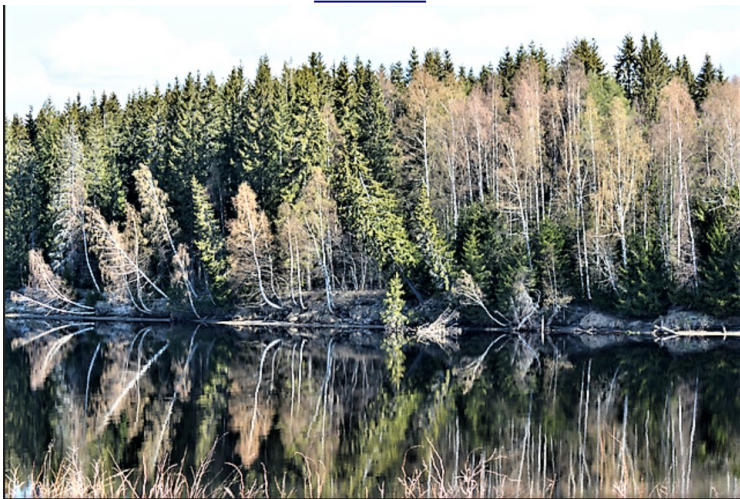
# SOLØR – ON THE WEST SIDE OF GLOMMA

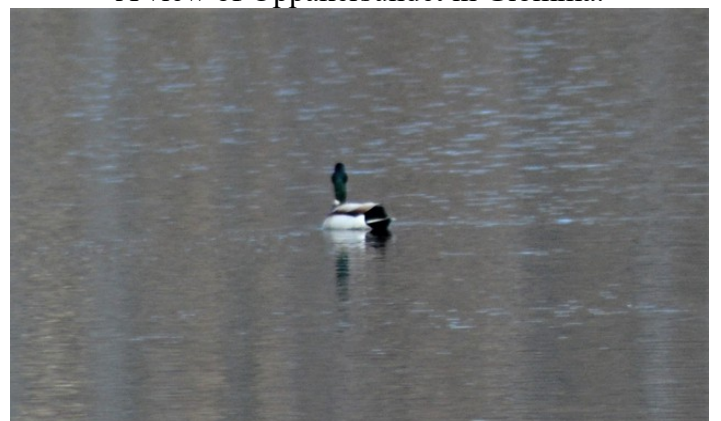
The next stop was at Evja.

There has been a shop in this house in the old days.

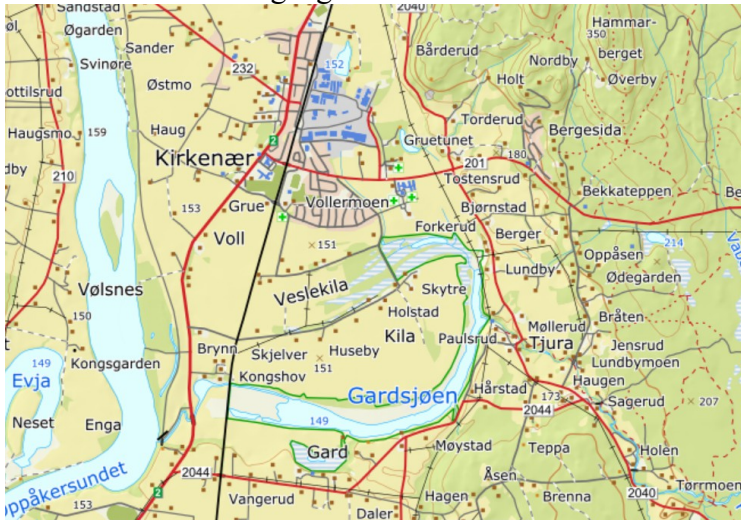




This advertising sign still is outside the house.
